

Ministry seeks teachers, officials' list

Education ministry on Sunday asked the education boards for the names of the teachers and officials, who were arrested or suspended from their jobs for their suspected involvement with leaking questions during the last Secondary School Certificate examinations.

A high official of the ministry said they were mulling over taking stern action against the suspected teachers and employees.

The ministry came under severe criticism after the questions of 12 subjects leaked in 12 days out of 17 days of this year's SSC exam, said Dhaka Education Board acting secretary Shahedul Khabir Chowdhury.

Earlier in February, during the exam, cops arrested 153 people, including at least ten teachers, and 53 cases were filed in this connection.
