Ad-hoc appointment of 1,804 Govt College teachers regularised

President approves BCS (Edn) cadre strength at 8,559

after due scrutiny by the Ministry of Education, regularisation of ad-hoc appointment of 280 teachers of government institutions, and regularisation of ad-hoc appointments of 1,804 teachers of nationalised colleges.

Government services under the Republic were brought under different cadres in September 1980 and accordingly the first class jobs in General Education and in technical education were divided in sub-cadres, namely BCS (Education—General Education) and BCS (Education—Technical Education).

Only 1,018 out of 8,000 first class posts in the General Education sub-cadre were permanent and these were encadred at the preliminary stage. But out of those 1,018 posts, only 363 teachers had permanent appointments and so the cadres was limited to this number.

On the other hand, in the Technical Education sub-cadre, 194 out of 1,047 posts were permanent with only 16 teachers

having permanent appointments. So the Technical Education sub-cadre was limited to only 16.

Following the publication of approved report by the Martial Law Committee on Reorganisation of Services the number of first class jobs in general education sub-cadre stood at 7,628 and that of technical education sub-cadre at 931. The Education Ministry submitted gradation lists of both the sub-cadres which were later approved in principle by the Establishment and Reorganisation Ministry. The gradation lists were prepared on the basis of seniority counted from the first date of joining the service.

The approval of the gradation lists became essential for the greater interest of teachers for removing their long standing grievances and improving teaching standard.

The encadrement in the sub-cadres under BCS (Education) will open up scope for appointment and transfer as well as

promotion both horizontally and vertically which was very limited beforehand.

The regularisation of services of 280 cases in Government institutions and 1,804 cases in nationalised colleges will help the persons in teaching profession enjoy all the Government benefits and remove their long standing grievances.

The Education Minister Dr. A. Majeed Khan was present during the signing of the approval of cadre list and regularisation of services by the President.
