

Make edn system free from malpractices

KHULNA, April 29: Education Minister Mahbubur Rahman has urged the government officials to dispose of files expeditiously so that the people were not harassed by running after the files, reports BSS.

He said mistakes committed while working could be condoned if they were bonafide but he added those who did not commit mistake were "either unwilling to work or remain like a dead man".

The Minister was addressing a meeting of the local MPs district and upazila officers of various departments, and heads of educational institutions at the Deputy Commissioner's conference hall here yesterday.
