BUET session runs 10 months behind

The on-going academic session 1983-84 of the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) has been running ten months behind the schedule.

The classes of newly admitted students to undergraduate courses under all the faculties of the university will not start before November, 1985. Their H.S.C. examination results were declared in August 1984. The new session starts after finishing all the examinations of all classes. The academic session of this university is counted from January to December.

The lapse of time in academic session began from 1980 session. The academic session was late by about four months. The delay of the session was due to shifting of examinations on students' demand. The classes of this session started in April 1980 which was scheduled to start from January, 1980.

The classes of the 1980-81 session started from August, 1981 which means the academic session was late by eight months. The delay was also due to unscheduled closure of the university for about two months as a sequel to the Plassey inci-

dent over the possession of land and shifting of examinations due to the devastating flood in the country in 1981. The 1981-82 and 1982-83 sessions also (See Page 14 Col. 3)

started in August and September respectively. The university was closed sine die for about two months in 1983 following February 14 incident. The regular session of the university also suffered due to hartals and other political reasons.

The university authorities can make up the loss of days caused by unscheduled closures by minimising the number of days of regular vacations.
