No exams for first graders

Students to be evaluated via assessments



There will be no examination for first grade student in the current academic year, according to a directive of the Directorate of Primary Education (DPE).

The directive, issued on Tuesday, said instead of graded examinations, the performances of the students will be evaluated through continuous assessment in accordance with the new curriculum.

The notification, signed by Monish Chakma, director of the Policy and Operations wing of DPE, included seven such directives for the upazila and thana education officers.

As per the directive, the evaluation process for classes 2-5 will continue to follow the procedures used before the pandemic.
