Shahjalal University of Science and Technology on Wednesday celebrated its 34th founding anniversary with colourful events.

The university vice-chancellor professor Farid Uddin Ahmed inaugurated the anniversary programmes at about 10:00am by hoisting national and SUST flag in front of the administrative building-2.

Later, a colourful procession was brought out from the Bangabandhu Chattar on the campus after releasing a bunch of balloons in the sky, marking the day.

A brief rally also was held at Muktamancha of the campus where the procession ended.

VC Farid Uddin expressed his gratitude to the personalities who had struggled to establish a university in Sylhet region since the British period.

Besides the anniversary programmes, the SUST campus was busy with a number of events, arranged by different socio-cultural groups to welcome the first day of the spring, according to the Bangla Calendar, and the Saraswati Puja, one of the popular ritual of Hindu community.

The SUST started its journey in 1991 with 3 departments, 205 students and 13 teachers. At present, around 11,000 students are studying in 28 disciplines under 7 faculties and two institutions on the campus.
