Compulsory Free Primary Education

Sir—The talk of compulsory free primary education for all is being heard for the last 30 years. The programme has so long fallen far short of achieving the desired goal and hence still remains in its embryologic stage. The case is not far to seek. It is beset with so many probems.

According to a study conducted by UNICEF a great member of our children are simply deprived of the fruits of education. It is reported that 41 per cent of our children belonging to pri mary school-going age fail _ to avail themselves of this opportu nity of free education. This may be attributed to inadequate num ber of schools, apathy on the part of parents want of proper motivational activities on the part of the relevant agencies. To this may be added distance of the school lack of teaching alos dearth of teaching staff and poverty of the people and some other socio-economic conditions. In spite of their best efforts, there are parents who cannot afford to buy books for their children not to speak of other requirements such as pen paper ink dress etc. To make compulsorv free primary eduction . . real success we shall have to remove the problems connected with it simultaneously —Yours etc. A.
