## Pilot project for primary education

CHANDPUR, Dec. 4:—The Government has undertaken a Taka four lakh-pilot project for the universal enrolment of children between five and ten years to primary schools in ten ideal villages of this subdivision says BSS.

An official source said the Ministry of Education in cope ration with the Bangladesh Arademy for Rural Development (BARD). Comilla will supervise the three year project to be completed in 1980.

The nation-wide universal enrolement of children to primary education will follow the success of the project, it added

The source said that children

would be admitted to three classes viz pre-class one class one and class two in the feeder schools to be set up in these selected villages under Meher Union Council. The existing primary schools in the area would admit students to other classes above class two.

The students would be provided with books, papers pencils and other reading materials. And the insolvent parents depending on the income of the children will be given financial help.

The ideal villages brought under the project are Naora, Sonapur Shahpur, Gugusal Barulia Pataro Khaneshar Upalata Suapara and Kaliapara.
