It is learnt that there was no cooperation Natun Bangla Chhatra Samaj and the newly formed National Student Front and the Chhatra Samaj leaders refused to draw a coordina. ted programme with the front. On October 29, the leaders of these two progovernment student organisations called on the Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor separately though their issue was same and they expressed similar views on the recent syndicate decision to suspend classes till November 12 in view of the situation arising out of the Jagannath Hall disaster. Besides the existence of

two major student forums, there is a third force active on the campus under the banner of "Sangrami Chhatra Oikya" comprising Biplobi Chhatra Andolan, Jatiya Chhatra Dal, Chhatra Federation and the breakaway faction of Chhatra! League (Pradhan). Politically they oppose Indo-Soviet axis and have a different programme though they work in collaboration with the student action committee. On the other hand, the university authorities are

facing a new problem following dissolution of the student unions by the government. In absence of elected student unions the university, authorities, often find it difficult to handle the student affairs through proper channel. The campus situation however depends on the overall political develop-/ ments in the country and

the wisdom and policy of the government and the political parties. Faced with the new situation, the student action committee, which claims to have initiated and spearheaded the democratic

movement against martial law regime has been maintaining low profile.. Though it has its own programme of action it could not decide. what should be the strategy suiting the new situation. Leaders of the action' committee admitted that in the past their programmes and strategy were guided by jectivity. They pointed out that a well thoughout programme and strategy could not be 'adopted' always as the action, committee is composed of forces belonging to different political ideas and ideologies, and the student fronts of political parties often acted according to the party policy and directives. They said the like-minded components of the action committee always tried to act together

leading to difference of opinion in the committee. On the other hand, some of the major student organisations-including Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal of BNP (Khaleda) and Chhatra Shibir of Jamaat-e-Islami-are not within the fold. of the action committee though they are in the movement along with the student action committee.
