WORLD BANK GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

For the Academic Year 1989/90

The World Bank with grant funding from the Government of Japan, has established a scholarship program for graduate studies leading to a higher degree in a development-related social science. The World Bank Graduate Scholarship Program is aimed at increasing the number of high quality professionals in economic and social development.

Scholarships are available to applicants mainly from developing countries who intend to pursue a career in a development field. It is anticipated that each scholarship recipient will return to their home countries at the conclusion of their studies to apply their enhanced knowledge and skills to help accelerate the pace of economic and social development.

Successful candidates must meet the following requirements before applying for a scholarship for the academic year 1989-90:

- * be under the age of 45 (normally under 35);
- * hold a bachelor's degree or its equivalent in the social sciences, law, business or public administration, or any other development-related technical discipline;
- * have a superior academic record;
- * have at least two years of recent experience in a public agency or public service organization engaged in development-related activities and intend to pursue a career in a development field;
- * have been admitted to a university renowned for development research and teaching; and
- * will pursue an advanced degree at the master's or doctorate level over a two-year study period.
