Open university under study

The Government is considering the possibility of setting up UNESCO Regional Office, try Education Secretary Quazi Jaialudlin Ahmed Said BSS.

Meanwhile, the workshop recommended the establish. ment of an university as soon as possible. It called to streng. then the BIDE and suggested that the institute should have regional centres all over Bangladesh and research cell may be added to it.
