Contd from Page-1 took part in the raid but failed to recovery, any arms, or ammunition. The raid was conducted in the wake, of a ! gunbattle between two Chhatra League (N-S) groups on Friday.

The arrested students are Mizan

and Mozzammel.

Earlier, five Islami Chhatra Shibir activists were assaulted including its former General Secretary of Suryasen Hall committee, Hazrat Ali allegedly by the members of Chhatra League (A-A) in and around Arts ; Faculty area at noon. The identity of other victims could not be ascertained. Police, then rescued. the victims from the hand of agitating students.

The Shibir activists came under attack following the incident of Fatikchhari in which four BCL; (A-A) workers were killed by Shibir and National Democratic Party (NDP) activists on Friday.
