Tk. 9.5 cr. spent on Islamic Versity

The Education Minister, Mr. Mahbubur Rahman, told the Jatiya Sangsad that Taka nine crore 42 lakh 22 thousand was spent for the constructin work of Islamic University till date since its foundation was laid, reports BSS.

Replying to a question from Mr. Rashed Mosharraf (AL-Jamalpur) the Education Minister further told the member that a Tk. 16 crore 93 lakh 24 thousand scheme was taken up in the year 1980 for setting up of an Islamic University in the country.

Replying to supplementary question from Syed Altaf Hossain (NAP-Kushtia) the Education Minister said that the Islamic University was being set up at Board Bazar in Tongi under Gazipur district.

He further told the Member that the Government had decided to set up an Agriculture College at Santidanga, a place bordering Kushtia and Jessore.

In reply to another supplementary question from Mr. Hasanuddin Sarkar (JP-Gazipur) the Education Minister said that so far Taka 62 lakh 71 thousand had been procured for the Islamic University.

The Education Minister told the Jatiya Sangsad that of the total amount Taka 24 lakh 71 thousand received from Islamic Solidarity Fund, Taka 20 lakh from Brunei and eight lakh 75 thousand from Rabita-E-Islam.
