13 Chhatri Sangstha activists detained

LAW enforces detained 13 women suspecting they were activists of Islami Chhatri Sangstha, a wing of Islami Chhatra Shibir, in front of National Press Club at Segunbagicha Saturday afternoon.

Witnesses said law enforcers detained them at about 3:00pm from the west gate of the press club where they had gone to attend a roundtable meeting arranged by a women rights organisaiton.

Shabagh police duty officer Nurul Amin confirmed the incident and said they kept only six of the detained women in their custody after primary questioning.

No case was filed against them till 8:00pm, he said.

They arranged a roundtable meeting at the press club in the evening to protest at the arrest and demanding their release.

On December 17, the police arrested 20 activists of the organisation from their Moghbazar office in the capital.
