

## Assaulted BM College principal, predecessor made OSD

THE newly appointed principal of Government Brojomohun College, Shankar Chandra Datta, who was assaulted allegedly by a faction of college unit Bangladesh Chhatra League, was made OSD on Thursday.

Nazrul Islam, acting principal of the college, acknowledged the news and said they learnt it from the website of the education ministry.

The website circular order (no. shaa: 6/2-A-50/2006/170-Shikkha) dated 14-2-13, signed by senior assistant secretary Mohammad Nasir Uddin of education ministry, said that the transfer order (memo no Shaa: 6/2-A-33/2006/106-Shikkha, dated 30-1-2013) of professor Shankar Chandra Datta to join as principal of BM College being released from the responsibilities of the principal of Government Sher-e-Bangla College at Chakhar and that of professor Nani Gopal Das to join as the chairman of economics department at Government Brojo Lal College in Khuina being released from the responsibilities of the principal of Government Brojomohun College have been cancelled in public interest.

The order asked both the professors to join the directorate of secondary and higher secondary education as officer(s) on special duty, in short OSD within February 18.

The professors were not available for comment over phone.

Activists of a faction of college unit Chhatra League led by its joint conveners Moin Tushar and Nahid Serniabad, reportedly close to its former principal Nani Gopal Das, beat up and chased Shankar Chandra on Tuesday when he was coming to the campus to attend the first day in office.
