Above all in 1976 and 1977 some of the Boards gave general grace marks to the examinees while other Boards did As a result; students passing from the former Boards got 10-15 marks more than their counterparts from latter Boards This, when doubled, becomes 20.30 and creates a huge difference between the marks obtained by candidates having the same academic calibre but passing from different Boards: As a result thousands of brilliant students will not get a fair chance: of admission. Therefore quota system is a MUST.

As the number of admission seckers is double this year, the number of seas should be increased by at least 50%, if not more. Later on classes may be taken in double shifts. Even in single shifts there will not be much difficulty as the lecture galleries and dissection halls etc of the Medical Colleges are hig. enough to accommodate more students than usual. Just that both the teachers and the students will have to work a little harder with more co-operation.
