Algeria to train 20 petroleum engineers per year

Algeria will provide training facilities for 20 Bangladeshi Engineers per year in the field of Petroleum engineering, according to an agreed minutes signed between the two sides in Dacca on Friday reports ENA.

The minute was signed following discussions between Petrobangia officials and members of an Algerian delegation headed by Mr. Abdur Kader Maachou, Adviser to Algerian Minister for Petroleum.

Mr. Maachou on the eve of his departure for home told newsmen at the Dacca Airport that negotiations were going on satisfactorily or setting up of a petroleum institute in Bangladesh with Algerian assistance.

A team of experts was now examining various aspects of the institute. The nature and areas of Algerian assistance will be worked out later on the basis of its report.
