

Two DU JCD leaders expelled

The Dhaka University authorities on Thursday expelled two students temporarily in connection with Tuesday's violent incidents as per the report of the high-powered probe body.

The expelled were AKM Amjad Hossain Shishir, third year student of Sociology Department, and Murad Khan, second year student of Mass Communication and Journalism Department. Both the expelled are mid-level leaders of DU unit of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD).

The probe body headed by Pro-Vice-Chancellor Prof Zinnatun Neasa Tahmida Begum submitted the primary report to VC Prof Anwarullah Chowdhury on Thursday evening. The committee was given 48 hours time to submit the report.

The probe body will continue its investigation and will submit the final report by next seven days, university authorities said.

Meanwhile the central and Dhaka University unit leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) called on Vice Chancellor Prof Anwarullah Chowdhury at his residence on the Thursday evening.

During the call the BCL leaders welcomed the authorities' steps concerning Tuesday's incidents, said a DU Press release.
