

PM expresses indignation High level meet today to discuss DU situation

Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia who returned home last night after attending the Non-Aligned Movement summit has convened a meeting of her top policy planners this morning to discuss the situation arising out of unabated terrorism on the Dhaka University campus.

Prime Minister has assigned some Cabinet Ministers to make a report on the Dhaka University situation which will be submitted in today's meeting.

Begum Zia was looking tired at the Zia International Airport. She had a meeting with her party Secretary General and LGRD

Minister Abdus Salam Talukder and Home Minister Abdul Matin Chowdhury at her Cantonment residence shortly after her arrival. The Prime Minister expressed her indignation over the incidents. The two feuding groups of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) have been fighting gunbattles after the formation of JCD's central committee. The two

feuding groups also met in a joint meeting on Monday last and reconciled after intervention from the Party Chairperson Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia and Secretary General LGRD Minister Abdus Salam Talukder. Informed sources told The Morning Sun that stern action would be taken against the troublemakers who were involved in the gunbattle.
